

## **Policy for the Distribution of Data Town of Smithfield's Geographic Information System (GIS)**

The purpose of this policy statement is to provide direction to Town staff regarding the reproduction and distribution of data contained in the Town's Geographic Information System (GIS) in accordance with the Virginia Freedom of Information Act. This policy is intended to protect the integrity of the Town's GIS while providing for reasonable public access to this data. It is the further intent of this policy to establish a standard for providing this data that will not unduly disrupt the daily workings of the Department of Planning and Zoning.

With the foregoing in mind, GIS data, which is open to public inspection under the Virginia Freedom of Information Act, will be provided in accordance with the following standards:

1. The Town of Smithfield has provided GIS data as a public information resource for its citizens. Every reasonable effort has been made to assure the accuracy of the GIS data; however, the data may not reflect the most current information. The GIS data is subject to constant change, and its accuracy cannot be guaranteed. Errors and/or omissions are possible and the user of such data is hereby advised of that possibility. The GIS data should not be considered authoritative for navigational, engineering, legal, or other site-specific uses.
2. The Town of Smithfield disclaims any and all responsibility and shall not be held liable for any claims, causes of action or damages of any type or nature arising out of, or in any way connected with, the data or the use or performance thereof. This includes, but is not limited to, any claims, causes of action, or damages for costs of recovering, reprogramming, or reproducing any programs or data used with or stored with the GIS data, damage to property, damages for any personal injuries or wrongful death, or damages for any lost data, lost profits, lost savings, or any other special, direct, indirect, consequential, or punitive damages.
3. The GIS data provided by the Town of Smithfield shall remain the property of the Town, which retains all rights commensurate with ownership, including the right to sell, release, license, use or provide the data to others as it deems appropriate in its sole discretion and the copyright to the data and the form in which it is compiled and presented. All GIS data may not be sold or resold except in accordance with a sublicensing agreement with the Town of Smithfield.
4. **DISCLAIMER:** THE TOWN OF SMITHFIELD MAKES NO WARRANTY, REPRESENTATION, OR GUARANTEE OF ANY KIND REGARDING ANY GIS DATA PROVIDED HEREIN OR THE SOURCES OF SUCH DATA. THE TOWN OF SMITHFIELD SPECIFICALLY DISCLAIMS ALL REPRESENTATIONS OR WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.

5. GIS data requested will be provided within a period of five (5) work days unless it is determined that it is practically impossible in which event the requester shall be so informed and the Town will have an additional seven (7) work days in which to provide the records or to petition the appropriate Court for additional time when the request is an extraordinary volume of records. However, before proceeding with a petition to Court, the Town staff shall make reasonable efforts to reach an agreement with the requester concerning the production of the records requested.
6. The GIS data layers are available in ArcView, ArcInfo and/or AutoCad format, unless otherwise noted.
7. Any person or entity obtaining or using any GIS data, metadata or information (collectively referred to as data) from the Town of Smithfield's Geographic Information System (GIS) does hereby consent and agree to the terms and conditions set forth in this notice. If you do not agree to all terms and conditions, do not use any of the data that you may have obtained.
